



Hanging Cat toys for the Give a Day Get a Disney Day Program *(minimum requirement 30 toys per person)*

These toys are easy to make and the Kitties love them! Toys are a very important part of a kitty's well-being. These toys are used by our foster parents for bottle kittens and kitties in quarantine prior to their being available for adoption. They are fun and the more colorful the better! It's a great way to use up your scrap fleece or buy from the remnants table at your local fabric store. You can even use lightly used baby blankets. It doesn't matter if the material has different prints - it just makes them more colorful and attractive to the kitties!

Materials needed:

1. Circular shower curtain rings.
2. Fleece material in various bright colors (Please pre-wash in HOT water and dry prior to use).



Directions:

1. Cut the fleece into strips 8 inches by 1 ½ inches.
2. Cut one strip 12 inches by 1 inch.
3. Bowline knot (fold the strip in half, wrap around the ring and pull the ends through the looped end) the 8 inch strips all the way around the ring and pull very tight leaving the "connection" part of the ring uncovered.
4. Tie the 12-inch piece to the "connection" part of the ring to be used to hang the toys.

To qualify and meet your service requirement for the Disney Give a Day Get a Disney Day program you will need to make A MINIMUM of Thirty (30) toys per person ages 6 and up. No store bought toys will be accepted to meet the requirement. It is an opportunity to use your creativity, have fun and make something extraordinary for our wonderful feline friends!
